A letter from Pastor Brad Miller

From the Pastor

These are busy times for CLC with many significant events on the horizon. I invite you to redouble your prayers for our congregation as we move forward. Intentional Interim Ministry – like all ministries – has been complicated by Covid19. Normally, I would have facilitated a number of group events by this point. Unfortunately, such normal activities have been precluded at times and complicated at other times. Despite these challenges, the congregation is moving forward on an aggressive timetable to seek the next settled pastor. Let me outline for all of you the key steps moving forward:

- We elect our new Church Council and Officers on September 26th.
- The Council will have a planning retreat on October 16th.
- At the end of the retreat (or soon thereafter), the Call Committee will be formed.
- The Call Committee begins working with Pastor Brandt from CORE.
- The Call Committee provides the required profile information to the NALC.
- The NALC screens candidates and forwards one or more for the Call Committee to consider.
- When they have a final candidate, the Call Committee forwards it to the Church Council.
- When the Church Council agrees, a special Congregational Meeting is called for the purpose of voting to extend a Call.

I invite your extra prayers for CLC bearing in mind the following:

- The Pandemic has added a layer of abnormality to everything.
- This is CLC's first post-ELCA Call Process. We are a member of two denominations with two rather different approaches to pastoral selection. We have had very little lay involvement with either the LCMC or the NALC. Some of the cultural nuances are very subtle. Some of the constitutional and procedural differences are very bold. Hence, it is a crude but roughly accurate summary to say that: "We have to follow the NALC Call Process." Expect lots of questions, misunderstandings, and false assumptions in the months to come. Pray boldly that the Holy Spirit would overwhelm all of the complications.

Your primary and most essential contribution to this process is prayer. Pray for: the Church Council; The Call Committee; your Intentional Interim Pastor; all candidates at all churches in transition; our future pastor (already known by God); and the NALC staff who will select candidates for our Call Committee to consider. Beyond prayer, keep participating in these important ways:

Keep learning I will be starting a class between Sunday services which will feature
 "High Yield" by Berlin/Weems (the same book being studied by our staff and Church
 Council) plus interspersed special visits from visiting preachers. Of course, you will want
 to get your children and grandchildren to our regular Sunday School classes.

- **Keep worshipping**. We have been blessed to hear a great array of guest preachers during 2021. Their primary function is to proclaim God's Word. Secondarily, they remind us of the great breadth of styles that exist among preachers. We have three more special preaching guests in the coming months, from: the Carolinas, Liberia, and Warren! Focus on the message that each will deliver, but also contemplate how the same solidly centrist Lutheran theology can be communicated in richly diverse ways.
- Learn about our denominations. Lutheran Week for NALC (and CORE) was held in Corpus Christi just a few weeks ago. See the NALC website: https://thenalc.org/. Our Michigan Mission District of the NALC gathers on October 2nd in St. Joseph. The LCMC Annual Gathering will take place in Hilliard, Ohio from October 3rd to 6th. See the LCMC website: https://www.lcmc.net/.
- **Give constructive input**. Watch for your upcoming opportunity to participate in a survey which will give critical insights to the Church Council; the Call Committee, and your next pastor.
- **Keep connected**. The church is the Body of Christ. An arm does not wander off and wait to see if they think that they will like the new eye or ear. Social clubs do that sort of thing. Immature Christians do that sort of thing. If you intend to sit on the sidelines and wait to see if events unfold according to your likes and wishes, at least buy the self-identifying T-shirt: I am a shallow and immature occasional follower of Christ.
- Stop pouring sugar in the gas tank and/or feeding the pet tapeworms! Avoid the gossip and negativity. We have enough real work to accomplish. See the T-shirt above.

As a final side note, thank you. I have deeply appreciated your many expressions of concern in my crazy weeks of August: my car burning up; my replacement car in lowa in an accident; my wife's replacement car (enabling me to get her old car) delayed in production; tons of paperwork and computer work and expense switching from hosting the Servant Leadership Summit in Israel to Greece to Iowa; and the wonderful (but hectic) occasion of my daughter's wedding. I am quite relieved to be back at work in Warren!

Be advised: the progress of our new playground set has finally outpaced the weather delays! We hope to see it completed soon. Please be aware that this entire project has been funded by an anonymous donor – with approval and oversight by the Church Council and relevant committees. It certainly compliments the efforts of many to revitalize our youth ministry – but no congregational funds have been used. All who grumble are enthusiastically challenged to provide matching donations to the Capital Campaign!

August 24, no changes in the COVID policy (CORRECTED VERSION) PHASE 3 Guidelines set by the CLC council (May 2021)

We will continue to maintain **social distancing**, **3 feet apart** per the CDC guidelines when we gather.

- 1. Face Masks are suggested, but optional.
- 2. We will continue the **seating** of every other pew during worship using 3 ft. spacing.
- 3. Continuous **communion** will return, single file, one side at a time as directed by the Ushers. For those who choose not to go to the Altar, the Ushers will offer Communion kits.
- 4. All doors will open for entry as in pre-COVID.
- 5. We will continue to **disinfect** between worship services.
- 6. All CLC **Small Groups** may meet. Groups may bring in food and will be responsible for clean-up. All trash should be placed in a trash bag and placed outside the building in the appropriate trash containers. All unused food must be removed from the building. All groups must disinfect and clean up after meetings.
- Coffee Hour will follow the Small Groups guideline <u>except</u> for food items. Individual food items will be purchased by Fellowship Committee only. No outside food items are allowed.
- 8. We will continue to collect the church **offering** in the Narthex.



CLC MUSIC MINISTRY - FALL REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

The time has come to rev. up our rehearsals for Autumn, Advent and Christmas seasons! There is a music ministry opportunity for any member of the CLC community who wants to test a call from God to become involved.

<u>Festival Choir</u> – open to all members from age 7 to 100! We sing well known and fun to sing hymns & songs. A short rehearsal is held on Sunday about 15 minutes before the beginning of worship.

<u>Adult Choir</u> – open to all confirmed members. We rehearse weekly from September through Trinity Sunday in the Spring. Adult Choir sings at three 9am services in each calendar month. We also participate in special events like Christmas services, Ash Wednesday and Holy Week.

Two rehearsal times are available, 10am on Tuesday morning and an evening, make-up rehearsal arranged as needed.

<u>Adult Handbell Choir</u> – Some openings are now available. We ring at one or two services each calendar month plus at specials events like Christmas services. We rehearse on Tuesday morning at 11am for one hour. An evening, make up rehearsal can be arranged as needed. <u>Youth Handbell Group</u> – please contact Melissa Bruesehoff for rehearsal times.

<u>Praise Bands</u> offer music selections at the 11am service. We have two Praise Band groups, CLC **Praise Band** and **Genesis Praise Band**. Please contact our Director of Music, Wes Fishwick, if interested in participating.

<u>Singers for Christ</u> is our children's choir. 2nd graders through 4th graders are welcome. We sing one or two Sundays a month. We rehearse two afternoons a week for one hour each. Piano/keyboard instruction is included in these rehearsals free of charge. This choir remains suspended at the present time until we have a clearer understanding of how to safely gather during the current variant wave of COVID.


